

**IN THE MATTER OF MANUFACTURE DATE OF
MOBILE HOMES NOT TO EXCEED 20 YEARS**

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

THIS DAY there came on for consideration by the Board of Supervisors of Panola County, Mississippi, a request stemming from the safety concerns of the citizens of Panola County. Upon a lengthy discussion pertaining to numerous safety issues of manufactured homes 20 years and older, and other noted concerns regarding the transporting and resetting of older mobile homes, the Board made a finding of fact that the polestar considerations of public safety would be best served by limiting the age of said product. Thereafter, upon motion by Supervisor Thomas and second by Supervisor Phelps, the Board voted as follows to mandate that a manufactured home must not have a manufacture date that is more ^{than} 20 years old:

Supervisor Phelps	yea
Supervisor Birge	nay
Supervisor Thomas	yea
Supervisor Avant	yea
Supervisor Flint	yea

Therefore, the Board hereby orders that the manufacture date of mobile homes to be placed in Panola County must not exceed 20 years from present date, effective October 1, 2019.
